Volunteering at ESNLC: Tony Cafani

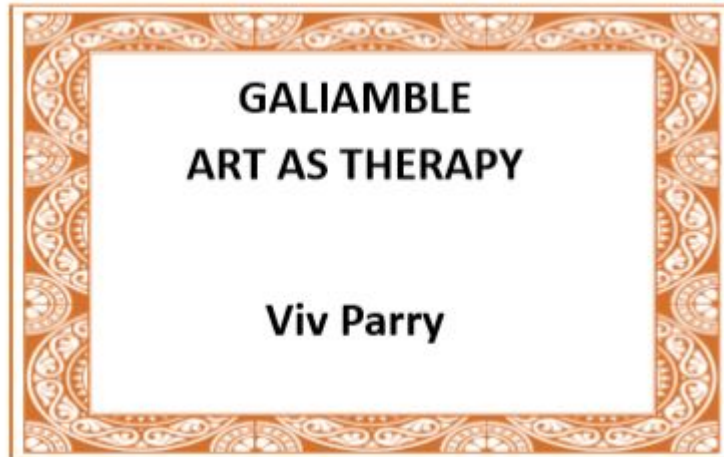
Elwood and St Kilda Neighbourhood Learning Centre offers opportunities to the local community to volunteer and contribute to the Centre in meaningful ways.

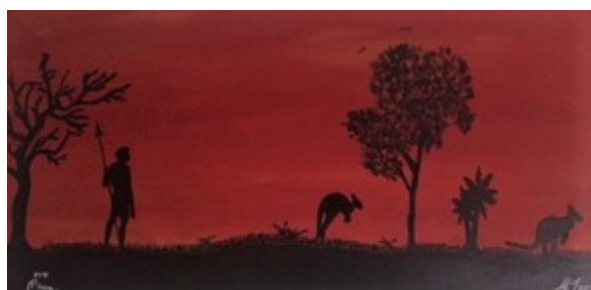

With the assistance of Vivian and Mark from Galiamble and Simone we produced a booklet for the participants to take home as a keepsake of the program and a second booklet that references the Aboriginal Peoples history.
