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

It is very difficult to get a job without experience but how do you get experience if you cant get a job?

This course is designed to provide the on the job skills and experience required to undertake a range of tasks and procedures required to work as a receptionist/office administrator. This is a great opportunity to get practical work experience in an office on your resume. A commitment of 8 hours per week will be required for training over approximately a 6 month period, this includes 3.5 hours on-the-job, 3 hours classwork and up to 1.5 hours of homework. Students will be given a training manual and required to complete a series of tasks covering the following topics under the daily supervision of a trainer.

General skills covered by the course include:

- word-processing
- · telephone skills
- · interaction with clients
- use of business technology
- · workplace safety procedures
- financial documents
- handling mail
- time management

Many students have gone on to employment or further training after completing this course and learning the skills required.
