Km	Stop Location
0.0	1. Poets' Garden (Rear of Elwood St Kilda Neighbourhood Learning Centre, 87 Tennyson St: choir home)
0.9	2. F.L. Dawkins Reserve (corner Broadway & Mitford St; typical Elwood architecture)
1.5	3. Sundial beside Elwood Canal (near John St; link to schools and local writer)
2.0	4. Elwood Sourdough (bakery and local institution – “Spotties” are highly recommended!)
2.4	5. Robinson Reserve (between Barkly St & Marine Parade; early settlement history; quarantine station)
3.1	6. Point Ormond hill (Bay look-out; history of Elwood Swamp)
3.3	7. Point Ormond Cafe (great place to stop for coffee or ice cream; open when weather is good)
4.1	8. Picnic area behind Elwood Sailing Club (foreshore bushland)
4.6	9. Elwood Pier (end of Head St; sea views; embedded tiles from 1999 arts and local history project)
5.0	10. Head St Reserve (Elwood Croquet Club, 1927; pretty little park)
5.8	11. Elwood Canal Linear Park (historic Sir John Monash Bridge; lush, leafy canal walk).
6.5	12. King of Tonga Bar (watering hole for Elwood Community Choir)
