0.0	1. Poets Garden (Rear of Elwood St Kilda Neighbourhood Learning Centre, 87 Tennyson St; ESNLC is the home of Elwood Community Choir; Sing "We Honour the Land")
0.9	2. F.L. Dawkins Reserve (Corner Broadway & Mitford St; sign on park bench; typical Elwood architecture; Sing "Tumbalalaika")
1.5	3. Sundial beside Elwood Canal (Near Keats St; sign on park bench; link to schools, local writer, old dance hall; Sing "Carry On")
2.0	4. Elwood Sourdough (78 Addison St; sign at bakery entrance; local institution; "Spotties" are recommended! Sing "In Toast We Trust")
2.3	5. Robinson Reserve (Between Barkly St & Marine Parade; sign on park bench; early settlement history; Quarantine Station; Sing "The Wark o' the Weavers")
3.1	6. Point Ormond Hill (Sign on park bench closest to top of hill; views of Port Phillip Bay and surrounds; Sing "The Sea")
3.6	7. Point Ormond Café (Foreshore promenade; sign near café, great place to stop for coffee or ice cream; Sing "La Mar Estaba Serena")
4.1	8. Picnic Area behind Elwood Sailing Club (Sign on pavement in front of picnic table; foreshore bushland; Sing "Nerm")
4.6	9. Elwood Pier (End of Head St; sign on pier wall; embedded tiles from 1999 arts and local history project; Sing "Round the Cape")
5.1	10. Head St Reserve (Beside Elwood Croquet Club, 1927; sign on park bench; pretty little park; Sing "All About Elwood")
5.8	11. Elwood Canal Linear Reserve (Foam St footbridge; sign on footbridge railings; lush, leafy canal walk; Sing "The Rakali Hop")
6.8	12. The King of Tonga bar (164A Tennyson St; sign at entrance; watering hole for Elwood Community Choir; Sing "Elwood Song")
